Core Responsibilities: The company specializes from the production, selection, packing, and export of **premium-quality fresh Cavendish bananas**, ensuring compliance with **international standards of quality, food safety, traceability, and presentation**. The fruit is harvested, processed, and prepared for export through post-harvest procedures that include authorized phytosanitary treatments, fungicide application, crown healing protection, ethylene control systems, export-grade packaging, and an uninterrupted cold chain, helping to preserve its quality, freshness, and commercial condition during storage and transportation. Bananas are packed in new corrugated cardboard boxes with reinforced lids, internal cardboard protection, and food-grade polyethylene bags designed to safeguard the product throughout the entire logistics chain. The fruit is harvested at an average physiological age of **10 to 12 weeks after flowering, ensuring optimal maturity for international export markets**; this reference relates exclusively to the physiological development of the fruit prior to harvest and should not be interpreted as post-harvest shelf life. Through strict agricultural and packing quality controls at origin, supported by traceability processes and internationally recognized inspection certifications, including SGS, AGROGESTAEC (AgroGesta Gold) guarantees consistent quality and compliance with the commercial specifications agreed upon with each customer. Under professional post-harvest handling conditions, refrigerated transportation, and proper logistics management, **the fruit may achieve a post-harvest commercial shelf life of up to 50 days, including ocean transportation, storage, controlled ripening processes, wholesale distribution, and retail display**, while maintaining commercially acceptable quality, appearance, and condition.

HARVEST AGE & SHELF LIFE

Bananas are harvested at an average physiological age of **10 to 12 weeks from flowering, ensuring optimal maturity for export markets.** This harvest age definition relates solely to fruit development prior to harvest and is independent of post-harvest longevity.

Under professional post-harvest management, including appropriate phytosanitary treatment, crown protection, ethylene control systems, export-grade packaging, refrigerated transportation, and uninterrupted cold-chain management, **the fruit is capable of achieving a commercial post-harvest life of up to approximately 50 days.**

Such life expectancy may encompass marine transportation, warehousing, ripening-room operations, wholesale distribution, and retail merchandising while preserving commercially acceptable quality standards. Actual performance may vary depending on transit duration, temperature management, ripening protocols, and destination conditions.

SHIPPING AND PACKAGING TERMS:

The shipping terms follow the **2020 Incoterms**, as recognized and published by the **International Chamber of Commerce (ICC)**. To ensure the safety and integrity of the goods during land and maritime transport, the following packaging terms and conditions apply:

FOR 22XU STANDARD BOXES:

- **Cargo inspection:** All cargo is screened using trained canines for detection of drugs and explosives.
- **22XU Box specifications:** The fumigated and cured bananas intended for export are packed in new 22XU corrugated cardboard boxes with lids. Each box includes internal cardboard protection and an internal vacuum-sealed polyethylene bag together with an ethylene control sachet, intended to preserve product quality and maintain its optimal stage of ripeness. Additionally, 2 to 3 adhesive labels (exporter's brand) are applied per cluster (custom sizes available upon buyer's request and seller's confirmation).
- **22XU boxes net weight:** 19.50 kg each net of fruit
- **22XU total boxes per pallet:** 54
- **Pallet type:** Standard Pallet (120 × 100 cm)
- **Pallets per container:** 20
- **Net weight per pallet:** 1053 kg net weight of fruit
- **Total boxes per container:** 1080 units, same boxes specifications as above.
- **Container type:** 40' Reefer (40RF)
- **Net load per container:** 21,060 kg (21.06 MT)
